### **Rumpke Park Manager Achieves Hall of Fame Status**

CINCINNATI, Jan. 31, 2010-- Danney Saylor, Rumpke Park Manager and Amateur Softball Association (ASA) Commissioner, was inducted into the Norwood Sorrento's Greater Cincinnati Softball Hall of Fame during an awards banquet 1 p.m. Jan. 31 at the Radisson Cincinnati Riverview Hotel, 668 W. Fifth St. Covington, Ky.

Throughout his more than 30 year tenure at Rumpke Park, the facility has hosted more than 200,000 games. Meanwhile, Saylor organized leagues and tournaments, coordinated concessions, developed umpire training programs and supervised park grounds. Saylor concentrated on ensuring justice at the park, enforcing protection for umpires, and developing a team enrollment system and standard classifications of play.

"I really have to thank Bill and (the late) Tom Rumpke (Rumpke owners) for giving me a shot," said Saylor.

During his tenure, Saylor not only brought a new level of professionalism to the park, he also continued the tradition of the Cincinnati Metro Tournament by bringing it to Rumpke Park in the late 1970s. He helped grow the Metro to become one of the largest amateur softball tournaments in the nation.

Even more commendable are Saylor's efforts to incorporate charitable giving into everyday park operations. Over the years, Saylor has raised more than \$2 million for various charities including the local March of Dimes, cancer research, muscular dystrophy and various others.

"At the end of the day, I hope the game is better," said Saylor.
